

HP Deskjet 450 Mobile Printer vs Canon i80 Color Bubble Jet



Get more with the HP Deskjet 450

Lower cost color printing — The HP Deskjet 450 mobile printer has a lower running cost than the Canon i80 printer. HP's black and color CPP is 24% lower than Canon's printer.¹ HP's upfront purchase cost including Bluetooth is also lower than Canon's.

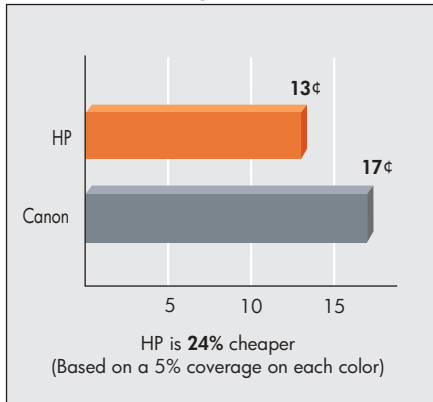
High performance for business — The HP Deskjet 450 has better image quality than Canon's unit. Based on internal testing Canon's business graphic printed output shows more faded color tones and lesser contrast.

- **media and ink intervention:** The HP Deskjet 450 holds 45 sheets of paper - 33% more than Canon i80's 30 sheets. The Canon i80 users will have to deal with ~ 4 times as many ink replacement interventions as HP Deskjet 450 users. With HP's higher yield ink cartridges, you will not need to carry extra supplies.
- **connectivity:** Both HP and Canon devices support USB and infrared connectivity. The optional Bluetooth interface in HP's unit is a standard model while the Canon's device is an accessory which is not easily available.

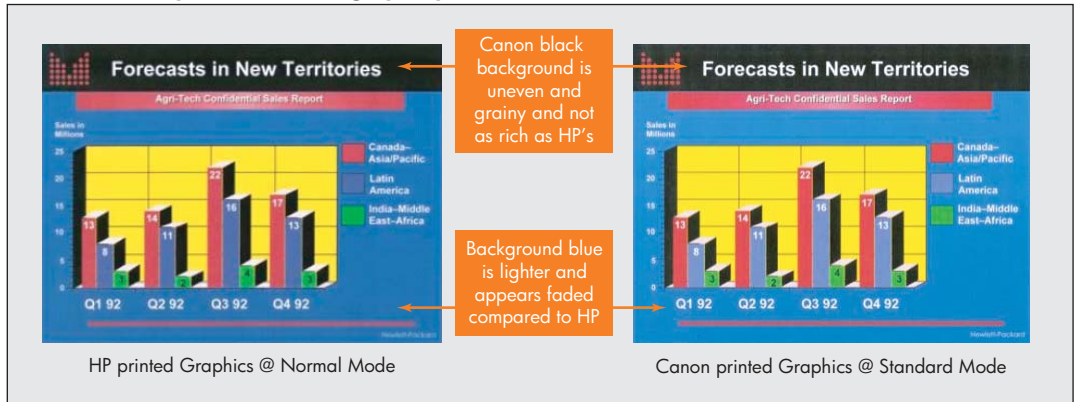
Ease of use

- **operational footprint:** The HP Deskjet 450 has a smaller operational footprint and occupies a more compact work area even when opened as compared to the Canon i80 printer.
- **battery change:** The snap on battery installation is a breeze for the HP Deskjet 450 as compared to Canon i80's screw-in unit which has several components.
